



Temporary Procedures For Third Party Agency Residential Energy Conservation Inspections

- **Applicability:** Effective immediately, any NEW Single Family Residences and two Family Residences which are regulated by the 2006 ICC International Energy Conservation Code will require inspections to be performed by a City of Pittsburgh recognized Third Party Agency (TPA). This Initiative may be terminated without any advance notice.

- **Requirements/Steps:**
 1. The third party agency must be registered/recognized by the City of Pittsburgh and certified by the State Department of Labor & Industry.
 2. The Applicant must hold a valid residential building permit that has been issued by the Bureau of Building Inspection.
 3. The Applicant must complete the “**Application for Third Party Agency Inspection**” form. Along with the aforementioned form, the applicant must submit a copy of the valid Residential Building Permit to the TPA performing the Residential Energy Conservation Inspection
 4. Inspections shall be performed to verify compliance with the 2006 ICC International Energy Conservation Code, as amended per the City of Pittsburgh.
 5. Upon completion of the Inspection, the TPA must send the completed inspection report(s) and Compliance Statement to:
