

The Pittsburgh Commission on Human Relations (PCHR) investigates complaints of alleged discrimination in employment, housing, and public accommodations within the City of Pittsburgh as they effect the following protected classes: race, age, sex, sexual orientation, handicap or disability, family status, ancestry, national origin, place of birth and religion. CHR is tasked with investigating civil rights violations and any conditions having an adverse effect on intergroup relations in the city. In addition, CHR conducts community education and other outreach programs for schools, community groups, businesses, professional organizations and City departments in order to promote equal rights and opportunities for all who work, live or visit our city. For over 50 years, CHR has successfully resolved issues of unfair and discriminatory practices faced by Pittsburgh residents.
