COURT RULES AND GUIDELINES

* All players must observe posted court and facility rules.

* Walk-in and flex-league players -without a Citiparks tennis permit - are limited to one (1) hour of play at a time per court, if there are players waiting.

* Any special event or clinic requires a Citiparks tennis permit.

* Only Citiparks Tennis instructors are permitted to give tennis lessons at Citiparks courts. Any other instructor must apply for a Citiparks tennis permit.
