NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES

**Pursuant to Title I, Article VII,
Section 161.38 (IV) (D):
Covered Employers under the
Ordinance must post the below
information in an area easily
accessible by all employees
at the job site(s).**

The City of Pittsburgh Service Worker Prevailing Wage Ordinance, passed by Pittsburgh City Council, requires contractors who provide building service and food services to the City of Pittsburgh to pay prevailing wages to employees employed pursuant to such contracts, and to require that building service, food service, grocery and hotel employees employed on projects receiving City subsidies be paid prevailing wages.

You must be paid not less than the "Prevailing Wage" rate as defined by the above referenced code and according to the schedule posted with this notice for the work you perform.

*****Employees: If you have been paid less than the above prevailing wage rate for your job classification, please notify the City Controller to request an investigation.**
