



Types of Maps available through the Interactive Pittsburgh Grid Map Website

For each block, the following 200-foot scale PDF maps are available for download:

- **Current Zoning Maps** (Color map)
 - Lot Block
 - Zoning code
 - Parcel number



- **Current Topographic Maps** (Color map)
 - Lot Block
 - Index and intermediate contours




- **Current Lot Block Maps (Color map)**

- Parcel number




- **1984 Lot Block Maps (Black and white map)**

- Parcel number




- **1984 Topographic Maps** (Black and white map)

When the Block or Parcel Number is known


1. Within the Interactive Pittsburgh Grid Map, the map of Pittsburgh is divided into a grid of numbered blocks.
2. Navigate to the known Block number. Block 1 is near the center of the grid, and the block numbers increase in a clockwise direction beginning with Block 1.

For example, use the Lot ID 2-J-164 which is the Lot ID for 200 Ross Street. The first number in the Lot ID indicates that the Point of Interest is located in Block 2.




- Click within the block's box.
- An information box for the highlighted block will appear which includes links to Zoning, Topographic, or Lot Block maps in addition to historical Lot Block and Topographic maps (1984 versions).


Navigate to and click on Block 2.



- Click the respective map link to download the PDF map




Click Current Lot Blocks Map Color for a map of lot blocks within Block 2.



6. Navigate within the PDF to view lots and parcels


Zoom in to Lot J as indicated by the second identifier in the Lot ID 2-J-164. Within Lot J, navigate to parcel ID 164 as indicated by the third number in Lot ID 2-J-164. This is the location of 200 Ross Street.




When the block number is unknown

1. Type the address, city, and zip code in the **“Find address or place”** search bar on the top right hand side of the map. Be sure to include the **city and zip code** in order for the search to work properly.
2. Press Enter. The map zooms to the entered address.


The following example shows the search results for 200 Ross Street, Pittsburgh PA 15219.



3. Click Zoom To in the “Find address or place” box that has appeared. The block associated with the address is now highlighted in blue.



4. Click anywhere within the highlighted block to access links to the 200-foot scale PDF maps for that block. The map index block number is also listed within the information box that appears. For instance, the information box states that 200 Ross Street is located in Map Index Block 2.



5. Once the block is identified and selected, the block's Zoning, Topographic, and Lot Block maps can be downloaded simply by clicking the respective map link.
