What?

We're hosting the final round of public meetings for **OPENSOURCEPGH**, the Open Space, Parks, and Recreation Plan for the City and one of the initial components of **PLANPGH**, the City's first comprehensive plan. **OPENSOURCEPGH** looks at the City's parks, hillsides, and vacant properties to determine where the City develops by what it preserves as its open spaces. These meetings will give an overview of the **OPENSOURCEPGH** draft plan and its recommendations, provide residents with a primer on how they can use the plan to help create change for the open spaces in their community, and to help determine priorities for each region of the City.
