



Location Plan NORTH 




Parcel Diagram NORTH









The deep ribbed metal panels help to take a large surface area and give it relief, depth and shadow lines



Examples of metal panels with color variations



Smooth metal panels

These panels allow for grid lines which can create a pattern with both panel sizes and color variations

Example of translucent panels



Translucent panels

The panels will allow diffused light to enter the plant during the day and give the illusion at night that the dark façade above is floating.

Example of curtain wall glass system used on stair tower



Curtain wall

The glass curtain wall system allows for transparency in the stair towers. The stairs add a vertical element to the predominant horizontal volumes. This feature would also be lit internally at night.
