

2. Pennsylvania Resources Council Artistic Board Up Project (Conceptual and Final Review)

The project is planned to be completed by July 1, 2016. The Hilltop Alliance stated that they will assist with routine maintenance of the properties once PRC completes the project.

Shea stated that they will only when it is safe to do so.

Gable stated that DPW will still supply the lumber if they need help boarding up the sites, they need to contact DPW.
