CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT ASKS DOES THE CITY HAVE MONEY FOR YOU?

Pittsburgh... There are 900 residents that are owed money from the City of Pittsburgh, in amounts ranging \$1 to \$26,000. Attached is a list of names. Listed residents have until April 1, 2013 to claim these funds before the money gets forwarded to the State. If your name appears, contact Council President Harris's Office at 412.255.2135 to verify that these funds are for you and not for someone else who shares a name with you.

Unclaimed money, by law, must be turned over to the appropriate state governments. Fortunately, City Council President Darlene Harris has pushed for a more proactive attempt in returning this money to the rightful owners. This cash belongs to ordinary people like you.

Proof of ID may be necessary, such as a copy of driver's license or another form of government-issued photographic identification. If you can prove you are entitled to the money, we will gladly return it to you. Are you one of these people?
