

Councilwoman Gross's Legislation FAQs: Tax Discount Extension

A brief resource guide to help understand new legislation passed by Pittsburgh's City-Council

What is it?

An ordinance extending the time period in which residents can pay their real estate tax bills while receiving the 2% discount for early payment.

When was it introduced?

The resolution was introduced by City Council on February 3rd, 2015 and was approved by City Council on February 4th, 2015.

When is the new deadline?

Pittsburgh residents will now have until February 28th to pay their real estate tax bills while receiving the 2% discount.

Why is this needed?

There was a delay in getting tax bills to city residents. There was on average a two-week delay and many residents found themselves with little more than a week to meet the February 10th discount deadline. City Council is now making up for the lost two weeks by providing an extension to residents.
