



Spring Yard Waste Curbside Collection Guidelines May 16, 2015

The first of the City of Pittsburgh's special biannual curbside yard waste collection is coming up on Saturday May 16th. Your participation in this program helps the environment by diverting valuable resources from the landfill.

Yard waste includes:

- leaves
- branches (4 inch diameter or less)
- brush
- grass



Place at the curb in the your normal recycling/ refuse pick up spot before 6:00 a.m. the morning of May 16th:

- in paper bags weighing less than 35 pounds
- bundled with fiber twine or natural rope in branch lengths of 5 feet or less

Yard Waste should **NOT** contain any of the following prohibited materials:

- Plastic bags
- Metal or wire
- Rocks, Blocks, Bricks
- Soil, Dirt, Gravel
- Glass, Metal or Plastic



Yard Waste found not meeting collection guidelines will be left at the Curb
