- **televisions** (first two free, \$10 - \$15 charge for each additional)
- **computers and peripheral equipment**
- **stereos, large speakers**
- **ink and toner cartridges**
- **cell phones, home phones**
- **small appliances**
- **CFL bulbs** (first 5 free, \$1 per bulb for each additional)

## THE FOLLOWING FEES APPLY:

- **batteries** ..... \$ 1.50/lb
- **CFL bulbs** (first five free) each additional ..... \$ 1.00 each
- **fluorescent tubes** ..... \$ 0.25/ft
- **small Freon-containing appliances** ..... \$ 10
- **televisions** (first two free) each additional:
  - 25" or smaller ..... \$ 10 each
  - 26" or larger ..... \$ 15 each
- **paper shredding** ..... \$ 5/box *proceeds benefit PRC*
