## REFUSE

### Household trash

In addition to household refuse, crews will accept chairs, bikes, small appliances, garden tools, end tables, ironing boards, roasters and grills.

Place all refuse at the designated site on collection day in plastic bags or bagged and placed into a container not exceeding 35 gallons in size.

### Carpeting

Carpeting and fencing must be tied in bundles not exceeding 35 pounds or 5 feet in length.

### Leaves and Shrubs

Leaves should be taken to a recycling drop off location nearest you.

Please note however:

Up to 5 bags of grass will be collected curbside as household trash. All bags exceeding the 5 bag limit must be removed from the curb before 5 a.m. on the day following your collection day.

### Curb side

**CITY DOES NOT COLLECT**

carpeting installed by a professional, construction, **TV's, computers & monitors**, building, explosive, medical, hazardous, infectious or flammable materials as well as car and automobile parts, bricks, cement, glass blocks, or marble or stone countertops.

### Weekly pickup

Place at curb no earlier than 7 p.m. on the night before collection and no later than 5 a.m. on the day of collection.

## BULK ITEMS

Bulk items include large items such as furniture, washers, dryers, stoves and discards from small renovation projects.

These may include sofas, recliner chairs, tables, box springs, mattresses, dressers, toilets, hot water tanks and windows.

**Any excess material will NOT be collected unless special pickup arrangements are made in advance. A cost of \$100 for each half-hour applies to special pickup. Call 412-255-2773.**

### CAUTION:

Wrap sharp objects (glass/ metal) in heavy paper & place in a box sealed with tape or string.

Place needles, syringes and lancets in a hard plastic container with a tight-fitting plastic lid, labeled as medical waste.

Place animal feces/litter in double plastic bag and place outside the refuse container.

### Curb side

(maximum 2 bulk items per week)

**CITY DOES NOT COLLECT**

Freon appliances (refrigerators, air conditioners or dehumidifiers), **TV's, computers & monitors**.

### Weekly pickup

Place at curb no earlier than 7 p.m. on the night before collection and no later than 5 a.m. on the day of collection.

FREE for City residents  
See above for costs for special pickups.

## PICK UP or DROP OFF

Place the items below together in the same blue plastic bags (no separation necessary).

**Please rinse all containers and discard all plastic caps and lids. No Styrofoam!!!**

**Rigid Plastic Containers (1, 2, 3, 4, 5)  
Glass Containers  
Metal Containers (including aerosol cans)  
Newspapers  
Magazines, Catalogs & Paperboard  
White Office Paper & Junk Mail  
Paperback and Hardcover Books  
Phone Books**

**Do not add other items**

Residents may also place blue bags in bright blue containers not exceeding 35 gal in size and clearly marked "Recycling"

**Corrugated Cardboard**

Take the individual items below in separate bags to the recycling drop-off center nearest you.

**Must be flattened and tied or flattened and bundled into boxes**

### Curb side

City collects recycling every other week. You may also drop off at the recycling center nearest you.

### Every other week

Place at curb no earlier than 7 p.m. on the night before collection and no later than 5 a.m. on the day of collection.

CITY OF PITTSBURGH

RESIDENTS ONLY (proof required)

**Leaves, Grass, Plants, Tree Trimmings, Branches, and Shrubs**

loose or placed in paper bags (no plastic bags accepted)

**CITY DOES NOT ACCEPT** stones, dirt, rocks, manure, garbage, lumber or food waste. (Stones, dirt, rocks also not collected at curb side.)

### TIRES

limit 2 per day

### SCRAP METAL

(no Freon appliances)

Special curbside recycling collections for yard debris only are conducted twice per year. See green dates on calendar.

### TV's & Computers

Televisions, computers, and computer peripherals including monitors, keyboards, mice, external drives, and printers must be taken to an electronics retail store to be recycled at no charge.

### Freon Appliances

To make arrangements to dispose of Freon appliances (refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers), contact Construction Junction (412-243-5025) or Appliance Warehouse (412-381-8800).

### Take to Retailer! **ONLY**

Televisions, computers, and computer peripherals including monitors, keyboards, mice, external drives, and printers must be taken to an electronics retail store at no charge. **These items are banned from the landfill.**

Call the electronics retail store or visit their website for opening hours.
