

CITY OF PITTSBURGH 2010 PARKING TAX BULLETIN

PARKING TAX RATE CHANGE

Per the Pennsylvania State Act 44 (HB1828) of 2009 the City of Pittsburgh Parking Tax rate will remain at thirty seven and one half percent (37.5%) rate for 2010. The rate shall be applied to all taxable considerations collected in January 2010 and to all subsequent 2010 taxable collections. The rate will be reported on the January 2010 Parking Tax Monthly Report form due February 15, 2010. All 2010 monthly Parking Tax reports shall show parking tax collected at the thirty seven and one half percent (37.5%) rate.

CALCULATION EXAMPLE FOR THE PARKING TAX

If a parking place collects a total charge of \$10.00 to park, **including tax**, the parking tax would be calculated by taking $\$10.00 \times .27273 = \2.73 . In this example, for each car parked at \$10.00, the operator would keep \$7.27 and send \$2.73 to the City of Pittsburgh.
