The City of Pittsburgh will hold two public hearings to seek public comment from interested citizens, community organizations, and the business community on the 2014 Capital Budget. The hearings are being held prior to the release of the 2014 draft Capital Budget to enable the City to adequately review citizen testimony. These hearings are *separate* from the 2014 Community Development Block Grant Program hearings.

Each year, citizens have the opportunity to make public comment at budget hearings that inform key decision-makers about what is needed in our communities. The City of Pittsburgh is committed to providing its citizens a transparent, fair, and equitable distribution of Capital funds. Community priorities and feedback are vital to directing the City's resources appropriately, in order to provide effective stewardship of our infrastructure and maintenance of the public's assets.
