Couldn't make it to any of the City's Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Campaign events?
Don't despair...

The seasonal influenza vaccine is available to all City of Pittsburgh employees at no cost. Simply go to any **Rite Aid Pharmacy** in the Pittsburgh area starting October 26, 2015.

There is no appointment necessary.

Just bring your City of Pittsburgh ID & medical insurance card to any Pittsburgh area **Rite Aid Pharmacy** to get vaccinated.

Ongoing, free-of-charge, no co-pay

Note: the free-of-charge vaccine is only available to those presently employed by the City of Pittsburgh who present a City of Pittsburgh ID & medical insurance card; employees' spouses, dependent and other family members are NOT eligible for this promotion.

The Department of Health and Human Services has issued recent guidelines recommending the seasonal influenza vaccine for all people age 6 months or greater.
