You will notice two changes on your Form W-2 this year.

- Health Care Reform requires the cost of employer sponsored health care be reported in **Box 12, Code DD**. This is for information only.
- Act 32 restructured the collection and reporting of **Earned Income Tax**. **Box 14** identifies the Political Subdivision (PSD) code assigned to your local residence and Tax Collector. You will need this number to file your final local tax return. **Box 20** lists the Tax Collection District (TCD) code where your withheld local taxes were deposited. IF, these codes are not listed on your Form W-2 or W-2C, please contact us immediately.

The Treasurer, City of Pittsburgh, no longer accepts local tax returns.
