

## WORKSITE SUPERVISOR'S AFFIDAVIT FOR PROVISIONAL SUPERVISION

1. I have applied to be a worksite supervisor with \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) and have been advised that as a condition of supervision, all applicants for this position are required to satisfy the requirements of the Pittsburgh Summer Youth Employment Program (PSYEP).
2. I acknowledge that PSYEP requires a Pennsylvania State Police Criminal History Report and a Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare Child Abuse History Clearance.
3. I further acknowledge that I will provide a copy of both the Criminal history report and the Child Abuse History Clearance report to \_\_\_\_\_(contractor).
4. I understand that \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) is prohibited from utilizing me as a worksite supervisor if I have been identified as the perpetrator of a founded report of child abuse committed within the past five years.
5. I affirm that I have not been identified as the perpetrator of a founded report of child abuse committed within the past five years.
6. I understand that \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) is prohibited by PSYEP from utilizing me as a worksite supervisor if I have been convicted of one or more of the crimes listed on Exhibit A to my Affidavit.
7. I affirm that I have not been convicted of one or more of the crimes listed on Exhibit A to my Affidavit.
8. I acknowledge that PSYEP permits \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) to utilize me on a provisional basis for a set period of time until all clearances have been received.
9. I understand and agree that \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) will immediately terminate my provisional worksite supervision if I am identified as the perpetrator of a founded report of child abuse committed within the past five years or have been convicted of one or more of the crimes listed on Exhibit A to my Affidavit.
10. I further understand and agree that \_\_\_\_\_(contractor) may immediately terminate my provisional supervision should the Pennsylvania State Police or the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare be unable to timely provide the required reports.

**EXHIBIT A TO**

**WORKSITE SUPERVISOR'S AFFIDAVIT FOR PROVISIONAL SUPERVISION**

\_\_\_\_\_ (contractor) \_\_\_\_\_ and its subsidiaries may be prohibited by the Pennsylvania Child Protective Services Law from utilizing a candidate who has been:

1. Convicted of one or more of the following crimes under Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes (Crimes Code), an equivalent crime under Federal law or an equivalent crime under the law of another state:
  - Chapter 25 (relating to Criminal Homicide including, criminal homicide, murder, voluntary manslaughter, manslaughter, causing or aiding suicide, and drug delivery resulting in death).
  - Section 2702 (relating to Aggravated Assault).
  - Section 2709.1 (relating to Stalking).
  - Section 2901 (relating to Kidnapping).
  - Section 2902 (relating to Unlawful Restraint).
  - Section 3121 (relating to Rape).
  - Section 3122.1 (relating to Statutory Sexual Assault).
  - Section 3123 (relating to Involuntary Deviate Sexual Intercourse).
  - Section 3124.1 (relating to Sexual Assault).
  - Section 3125 (relating to Aggravated Indecent Assault).
  - Section 3126 (relating to Indecent Assault).
  - Section 3127 (relating to Indecent Exposure).
  - Section 4302 (relating to Incest).
  - Section 4303 (relating to Concealing Death of Child).
  - Section 4304 (relating to Endangering Welfare of Children).
  - Section 4305 (relating to Dealing in Infant Children).
  - A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to Prostitution and Related Offenses).
  - Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to Obscene and Other Sexual Materials and Performances).
  - Section 6301 (relating to Corruption of Minors).
  - Section 6312 (relating to Sexual Abuse of Children).
2. Convicted of the attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit any of the offenses set forth in Paragraph 1 above; or,
3. Convicted of a felony offense under The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, committed within the five-year period immediately preceding candidate's application.
4. Convicted of any offense (felony or misdemeanor) in any jurisdiction of the United States.
