mentor2.0 pairs college-educated volunteers in one-to-one mentoring relationships with ninth grade students at Pittsburgh Brashear High School. A unique combination of technology and curriculum empowers volunteers to become an effective support to students through high school and beyond.

How It Works

Flexibility Everyone can accommodate the time commitment, including the busiest corporate executives and traveling professionals. Block off just two hours one evening per month for the in-person event; fulfill the remaining responsibilities remotely.

Structure Much of the mentoring interactions will be guided by a customized curriculum. Email prompts will help volunteers say the right things at the right times; pre-planned activities will facilitate in-person connections.

Impact Every mentor2.0 volunteer can provide a high school student with the support and guidance they need to graduate from high school and succeed in college and the workforce.

Volunteer Info

Volunteer Requirements:

- At least 21 years old
- College-educated (Associate's degree or higher)
- Live or work in the Pittsburgh area

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Complete application, brief enrollment interview and training
- Exchange weekly online communications with mentee
- Participate in a two-hour group event one evening per month at Pittsburgh Brashear High School (dates/times provided before school year begins)
- Commit two school years to the program – ideally, relationships will last through high school
