What is the Nuisance Bar Task Force?

The Nuisance Bar Task Force is a joint effort of the Bureaus of Police and Fire, the District Attorney's Office and Allegheny County Health Department, the State Liquor Control Licensing and Enforcement, and concerned citizens of Pittsburgh to rid our city of nuisance bar establishments that cause problems in our neighborhoods.

What makes a bar a nuisance?

Generally, a bar can be declared a nuisance if the activity in and around the bar is harmful to the surrounding neighborhood. Prostitution, sales to minors, and open and ongoing drug sales with the knowledge of the bar owner or employees are some of the problems.

Nuisance bars can cause problems in any Pittsburgh neighborhood. Noise, loitering crowds, narcotic sales, gambling, prostitution, lewd behavior, disorderly conduct, garbage, sale of liquor to minors, street crime and harassment are among the many problems caused by nuisance bars. By reporting these activities, you can help in the necessary action to rid your neighborhood of the problem. **Investigations into nuisance bars take time. Your report can begin or further the investigation of the liquor establishment and its illegal activity.**
