UNION: This position is included in the Pittsburgh Joint Collective Bargaining Committee and will be filled in accordance with the provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

DUTIES: Performs manual work of limited complexity; may assist in the performance of semi-skilled or skilled tasks; participates in various projects or tasks requiring physical labor such as street resurfacing, digging ditches, pruning shrubs, maintaining pipelines, valves, hydrants, and manholes; cleans streets, gutters, sewers, and catch basins; loads and unloads materials, supplies, equipment, trash, and other debris; salts streets and sidewalks and removes snow; assist craftspeople's in moving materials, setting forms, mixing cement, etc.; performs minor repairs on PWSA facilities, streets, sidewalks, stairs, sewers, etc.; performs simple construction jobs (e.g., barricades, fences, etc.); cuts grass and weeds, rakes leaves and performs related grounds keeping tasks; cleans buildings, offices and the surrounding grounds; uses a variety of hand and power tools and pumps, sewer rodders, power mowers etc.; may drive trucks of one ton or less in daily routine; may assist in locating mains and service lines and in backfilling excavations; performs routine maintenance of equipment (e.g., power saws, compressors, etc.); and other related tasks and duties that are assigned or required.

KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES: Ability to understand and follow simple oral instructions; to use appropriate tools and equipment. Physical capability to perform physical work outdoors in all weather. Ability to work in confined spaces may be required. Must be able to work all shifts.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Candidate must be domiciled in City of Pittsburgh at the time of appointment and remain domiciled in the City of Pittsburgh throughout employment with the PWSA. Verification of City residency required at time of appointment. Must present a current, valid Class C (Class 1) Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Operator's License at the time of application or prior to appointment. A valid driver's license must be maintained throughout employment.

Physical capability to perform laborer duties as described above in all types of weather.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION: Required prior to appointment to include ability to perform normal physical range of motion for lifting, reaching, pulling and carrying
