UNION: This position is included in the Pittsburgh Joint Collective Bargaining Committee and will be filled in accordance with the provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

DUTIES: Repairs, replaces and maintains all types of piping, valves, controls and plumbing fixtures in new or existing Authority structures or at assigned field locations; repairs, replaces and maintains all types of plumbing within or on Authority property (e.g., water, waste, gas and vent lines, restroom facilities; drinking fountains, fire lines, chemical lines, etc.) according to the rules and regulations of the Allegheny County Plumbing Code; repairs and replaces private water lines, gas lines, etc. damaged by the Authority; removes and installs water meters at private customer locations in accordance with established Authority policies and procedures; provides temporary water service to City property owners when normal water service is interrupted; responds on a 24 hour-a-day basis to emergencies involving problems with gas, water, compressed air, chlorine lines, sewer, waste and water supply emergencies; maintains records and prepares accurate reports as requested or required; directs the work of laborers or other assigned personnel on projects; may drill and tap new and existing service connections as requested or required; may overhaul evaporators and clean chlorine lines; may make field sketches identifying problems encountered as required; may work all three shifts; performs activities and functions of related lower-level personnel as assigned or required; performs such other related tasks and duties that are assigned or required.

KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES: Extensive knowledge of the materials, tools, equipment and procedures of the plumbing trade with competency at the journey level; and of the safety hazards and precautions of the work. Ability to read and use blueprints and plans necessary for job completion; to make mathematical computations; to make field sketches identifying problems encountered; to follow oral and/or written instructions; to lift heavy objects and to walk and stoop for extended periods in all weather; to direct the work of laborers or other personnel on a project basis; to maintain records and prepare accurate reports; to maintain a valid Pennsylvania Class C driver's license throughout employment; to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing; and to establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, associates, outside agencies and the general public.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Successful candidate must become a resident of the City of Pittsburgh at the time of appointment and must remain a resident throughout employment with the PWSA. Verification of City residency required at time of appointment.

Applicant must present a current, valid Class C (Class 1) PA Motor Vehicle Operator's License at the time of application or prior to appointment. A valid driver's license must be maintained throughout employment.

EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must present a current, valid Allegheny County Health Department Journeyman Plumbing License at time of application and maintain this license throughout employment.

EXAMINATION: Performance and/or written examination may be required.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION: Required prior to appointment.
