SUMMARY: The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (PWSA) is looking to fill a paid internship position in its Engineering and Construction Division. The PWSA is an authority of the City of Pittsburgh responsible for operating and managing water and wastewater infrastructure including a water treatment plant and pumping facilities.

DUTIES/PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES: The candidate will be required to edit/update potable water and/or wastewater GIS data including performing record information research, field investigations, etc. to support this effort. The candidate will also be required to provide development of CAD plans for various phases of planning and design projects. The candidate may also be required to support the Department's regulatory compliance group which involves data collection and statistical validation related to state and federal regulations. Additional duties may be added to support organizational and departmental needs.

KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES: Knowledge of Windows Office products is required for this position. Proficient in the use of technical related software (e.g. GIS, CAD, etc.) is desired. Must have strong ability to communicate (written and oral) effectively with technical and non-technical personnel.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Candidate must be domiciled in City of Pittsburgh at the time of appointment and remain domiciled in the City of Pittsburgh throughout employment with the PWSA. Verification of City residency required at time of appointment.

Must present a current, valid Class C (Class 1) Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Operator's License at the time of application or prior to appointment. A valid driver's license must be maintained throughout employment.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT: In order to be considered eligible for this position, the applicant must have an associate's degree, a bachelor's degree, or be working toward a bachelor's degree in Engineering, Environmental Science, GIS or an acceptable related field.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORKING CONDITIONS: The employee maybe required to field sample in a wide range of weather conditions.
