Hetz's Run Improvements (under construction)

The \$15 million state-funded project will open access to the Allegheny River for the first time in generations and enable planning for a grand entrance to the zoo and Highland Park. When the bridge and ravine work are finished, the city hopes to transform about one-third of the zoo parking lot near Butler Street into a lush greenway with an athletic field, bike and walking paths connecting East End neighborhoods to the river, and a deck overlooking the river and Highland Park Locks and Dam.


