The next license to be renewed this year is Bed and Breakfast. If a license was issued prior to June 6th, 2016, you will need to renew by August 31, 2016. You can read more about this license and download an application [here](#).

**We will require a new application, a City tax I.D., a valid Certificate of Occupancy for license issuance.** This may require some additional permits for those who have not been in compliance with the ordinance in the past and may cause some confusion.
