A. Approval of Meeting Minutes

March and April 2015 minutes were presented for approval. Slavick moved to approve the March minutes, Lockett was in favor. All approved. Slavick moved to approve the April minutes, Moss seconded. All approved.

C. Items for Review

1. ***Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh Knoxville (Final Approval)*** *Amanda Markovic, GBBN Architects*

Markovic presented the plans for the Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh Knoxville. The Library had been conceptually approved in March 2015. The Commission had asked to see material samples for the building. Markovic provided samples for the Commission.

Markovic stated that the library will be changed as such: This building, as a notable form of brutalist architecture, is to maintain its dramatic form while interior space is enhanced by providing more daylight, increased visibility, and made a more functional space. An addition is necessary to support the growing program of the library, this is shown on the southwest façade. The 370 sf addition is separated from the existing building by a glass reveal. In addition to this, two small openings are planned along the southwest façade and a pop-out has been added to the northeast façade. The additions will be clad in a dark metal panel, differentiating
