



The Pittsburgh

Technology Center is located along the Monongahela River in the neighborhood of South Oakland. The 48 acre park originally functioned as a hot strip mill and was later developed as a technology and research site. Currently it is home to the University of Pittsburgh and Carnegie Mellon University research and laboratory facilities as well as multi-tenant offices. Additions to the site include related mixed uses such as restaurant, retail, open space, and continued growth in office and research development.
