



South Side Works

is a brownfield redevelopment site located along the Monongahela River. The 123 acre site, located in the South Side Flats neighborhood, was formerly home to the Ling-Temco-Vought (LTV) Steel Finishing Mill. Designed to complement the vibrant East Carson Street Historic District, the South Side Works is as a mixed use development including office, residential, commercial retail, and UPMC sports training facilities. In addition, the South Side Work's location along the riverfront trail and views of Downtown Pittsburgh make this a popular entertainment destination., locally and regionally.
