



DIY Gallon Jug Bird House

It's easy to create a fun, functional bird house with materials you can find around your home!

YOU'LL NEED:

Empty Gallon Jug
Scissors
Permanent Markers
Paint/Paint Brush
Twine

1. Create a door to the house. Draw a circle on the front of your jug and poke a hole in the center of the circle with scissors by twisting one blade of the scissors back and forth. Slide the scissors through this hole and cut around the circle.



2. Make the loop to hang your bird house. Poke two holes in the gallon jug lid with the scissors. Thread the twine down through one hole and back up through the other. Screw the lid on to the jug tightly.



3. Add the finishing touches. Decorate with permanent markers, paint, etc.

4. Hang your bird house from a tree branch by securely knotting together the twine. Sit back and watch your new neighbors move in!
