

RESOLUTION

July 10, 2020

Recognizing the COVID-19 pandemic is an emergency affecting the best interests of the City, in accordance with Civil Service Commission Rule XX, Section 2, we hereby act on our emergency rule making authority to amend Rule III, Section 10, F. to add subparagraph (3) to require employee screenings after personal travel outside of Pennsylvania as follows:

RULE III EXAMINATIONS:

CHANGE

SECTION 10

WAS:

- F. (1) Any employee assigned to arduous or non-sedentary work as determined by the Civil Service Commission who has been absent forty-five (45) or more calendar days because of an approved Leave of Absence or due to a non-work related injury or illness, or because of a compensable work injury shall be required to take a medical examination prior to returning to work.
- (2) Any employee assigned to arduous or non-sedentary work as determined by the Civil Service Commission who has been on an approved Military Leave including National Guard or Reserve Duty forty-five (45) or more calendar days shall be required to take a medical examination prior to returning to work *(Revised 7/2019)*.

SHALL BECOME:

- F. (1) Any employee assigned to arduous or non-sedentary work as determined by the Civil Service Commission who has been absent forty-five (45) or more calendar days because of an approved Leave of Absence or due to a non-work related injury or illness, or because of a compensable work injury shall be required to take a medical examination prior to returning to work.
- (2) Any employee assigned to arduous or non-sedentary work as determined by the Civil Service Commission who has been on an approved Military Leave including National Guard or Reserve Duty forty-five (45) or more calendar days shall be required to take a medical examination prior to returning to work.
- (3) Any employee returning from personal travel during the COVID-19 pandemic must be screened in accordance with the City's Temporary Personal Travel Policy during the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHEREAS, the Commission is in agreement and approval of the requests, and they are in conformity with previous actions of the Commission regarding similar amendments of the Civil Service Rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Rules of the Civil Service Commission be amended to include additional language for Rule III, Section 10 and Rule XX- Amendment of Rules.
