COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN
SEPTEMBER 9, 2020

Re-Opening Date: September 27, 2020
Maximum Capacity: 22 people

Cleaning and Sanitizing Plan:

- The air filters have been replaced with MERC-13 filters to block 50-55% of airborne pathogens with each pass of air thru the filters in both the bubble and the office.
- The inner coil of the air handler system and the office A/C unit have been cleaned and sanitized.
- The touch surfaces in the bubble and office have been sanitized with an electrostatic sprayer that bonds to a surface at the molecular level, leaving a protected antimicrobial coating on the surface that can last for up to a year.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations have been installed throughout the tennis facility.
- Room dividers have been installed between Court 1 and the facility entrance.

Player Rules and Protocols:

- Occasional court time can be booked over the phone only. The office will be closed to the public.
- All court fees will be paid in advance by check or credit card. No cash accepted.
- Players should arrive no more than 5 minutes before their court time.
- Players will be required to wear a mask when entering the facility and when going to or from their court.
- City staff will check player's temperatures with a touchless thermometer before allowing them to enter the facility. Players will not be allowed entry if they have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher.
- City staff will also ask each player if they've had any symptoms of Covid-19 within the last few days and/or if they've been in contact with anyone who tested positive or presumed positive of Covid-19 within the last two weeks.
- Players should bring their own water bottles. There will be no water available in the facility.
- One bathroom in the office will be available to players for emergency use. Players should use the available sanitizing cleaner both before and after use.
- The showers in the bathroom will be closed and the lounge will be closed.
- Courts will be limited to 4 players.
- The City will not be offering tennis clinics until further notice.
- Spectators are prohibited and the bleachers will be closed.
- Players will abide by the "USTA Playing Tennis Safely Guidelines", which are attached and will be posted at the tennis facility.
