



## **ITEM 4901-0001 MINOR MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF TRAFFIC DURING CONSTRUCTION, MODIFIED**

In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 901, except as follows:

**DESCRIPTION** – This work is the furnishing, installing, maintaining and protection of traffic and pedestrian traffic adjacent to and within the work zone and the relocating of traffic control devices. This work also includes the subsequent removal of all temporary traffic control measures upon completion of construction. This work may also include the closure of a travel lane for all or a portion of the construction.

**MATERIAL** – Furnish material and traffic control devices necessary for maintenance and protection of traffic in accordance with PennDOT Publications 212 and 213, PennDOT Publication 408, Section 901.2 and the MUTCD as follows:

- Channelizing Devices – number not to exceed 60.
- Type A Warning Lights – mounted on channelizing devices.
- Type III Barricades – number not to exceed 4.
- Regulatory signs – in accordance with PennDOT Publication 236. Number not to exceed 6 signs.
- Construction/Pedestrian fence - amount not to exceed 200 linear feet.
- Wooden crosswalks for pedestrian traffic to bypass or bridge over work areas (as directed).

### **CONSTRUCTION –**

(a) **General.** Comply with PennDOT Publications 212 and 213, PennDOT Publication 408, Section 901.3 and the MUTCD.

(b) **Advance Requirements.** In the event that a driveway will be affected or of a lane closure, the contractor must notify the adjacent property owners, business owners, and residents at least 72 hours in advance.

Face-to-face notification is preferred, but at a minimum, impacted properties must be notified using a door hang-tag (furnished by contractor) that outlines important information related to the closure, including the area impacted, the expected start and end dates for the closure, and a contact number for the responsible contractor.

(c) **Coordination.** Coordinate working schedule with any adjacent local, County and PennDOT projects, as well as the City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure Permitting Division: 412-255-2530.

**(d) Work Restrictions.** No work is permitted on any City of Pittsburgh streets, without prior approval from the Owner's Representative, on Saturdays and Sundays or on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
- Good Friday
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Veteran's Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Day After Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day

Be advised that the City of Pittsburgh has a noise ordinance. No work is permitted before 7:00 am or after 7:00 pm. In the event that work outside of these hours is necessary, prior permission from the Owner's Representative is required. If working outside of these hours, obtain necessary permits prior to beginning construction.

**MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT – Day.** All items are incidental.
