



ITEM 9000-0006 SETTING OR RESETTING SURVEY MONUMENTS

DESCRIPTION – This work consists of setting or resetting survey monuments at the locations shown and as directed by the City of Pittsburgh Department of Public Works.

MATERIAL –

- Aluminum Monuments – Furnished by the City of Pittsburgh.
- Tubing – Furnished by the City of Pittsburgh.
- Class 1 Excavation – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 203.
- Class 1B Excavation – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 203.
- Borrow Excavation – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 205.
- Aggregate – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 703.
- Class AA Concrete – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 704, except must have a 28-day compressive strength of 4000 psi.
- Caulking Compound – In accordance with PennDOT Publication 408, Section 705.8(b).

CONSTRUCTION – Notify the City of Pittsburgh, Department of Public Works, Justin Salinetto at 412-255-0721 (email:justin.salinetto@pittsburghpa.gov) a minimum of 48 hours prior to beginning construction. Never move or disturb an existing monument without prior approval from the City of Pittsburgh Department of Public Works.

The Department of Public Works has a list of all monument locations. It is not the intent to replace all existing monuments. The Department of Public Works will establish and reference the location of the proposed monument.

Construct the monument without disturbing the reference points. Reset all reference points, which must be reestablished, at no additional cost to the owner.

Provide a 2'x2'x4' concrete slab for survey monuments constructed outside of the sidewalk area, at no additional cost. (As directed.)

When survey monument is placed in existing sidewalk, replace complete sidewalk slab, or as directed. Sidewalk replacement will be paid as the appropriate concrete sidewalk item.

Any survey monument casting that is removed and not being reused will be delivered to the Construction Division yard at 62nd Street.

Any monument removed and/or disturbed, prior to approval by the City of Pittsburgh Department of Public Works, must be replaced or reset, subject to Ordinance No. 33/1990, Section 419-09, as amended, and will be responsible to pay the fees set therein.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT – Each. Includes all labor and materials to complete the item of work, including all excavation, rock excavation, obtaining material from the City, concrete, backfill, compaction, subbase, caulking, and the satisfactory removal and disposal of all unsuitable and surplus material.
