

Manchester, North Side, District 6 – Neighborways are low-traffic streets that prioritize pedestrians, bicycles, and other non-motorized traffic and offer a safer, more comfortable alternative to busy arterial streets. Neighborways typically run through residential neighborhoods and use context-appropriate traffic calming tools to keep speeds slow and safe for all users. They aim to connect neighborhoods and feature clear signs and pavement markings to help people easily navigate through Pittsburgh. Existing neighborways can be found in Highland Park/East Liberty, Point Breeze, Lawrenceville, Southside Flats, and Bloomfield/Friendship.

The Manhattan St Neighborway will better connect the neighborhood of Manchester, including to the businesses, parks, and other destinations on and around Western Ave, while offering an alternative to nearby busy arterials. It will also connect to planned neighborways on adjacent streets. The route may include wayfinding, speed humps, neighborhood traffic circles, or other traffic calming measures, where appropriate.

### Proposed Project Elements

- Traffic calming -- Retrofitting the existing roadway with infrastructure designed to reduce speeds and conflicts among bikes, pedestrians and motor vehicles
- Painted bump-outs -- Intersection treatments to improve sight-lines
- Sharrows -- To indicate shared bicycle/motorized vehicle use of the street
- Signage -- Neighborway signage (below, left) and wayfinding signage (below, right) throughout the corridor to indicate specific street use, and safely direct cyclists and pedestrians to nearby destinations
