Allegheny West, District 1 – Perrysville Avenue is a two-lane road owned by PennDOT and the City. This roadway is included as part of the proposed bike network in the 2020 Bike(+) plan for the City of Pittsburgh. Most users of these facilities will likely be commuters and recreational cyclists.

Additional bicycle infrastructure from North Charles Ave to Mairdale Ave would provide users with a direct connection to the Marshall Avenue bicycle facilities proposed by DOMI as well as between lower Northside neighborhoods and the hilltop Perry North and South neighborhoods and Riverview Park.
