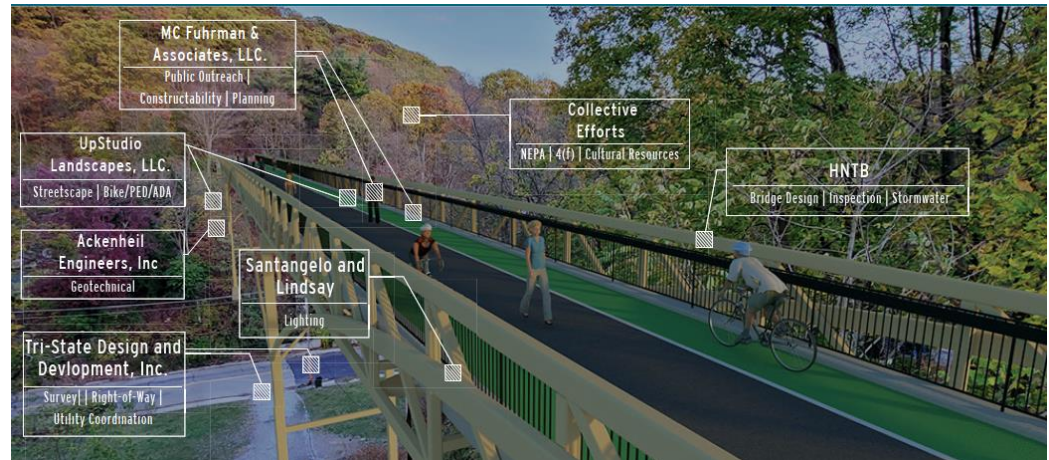

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Davis Avenue Concept and Consultant Involvement

Brighton Heights/Riverview Park – The Davis Ave bridge, previously demolished in 2009 due to deterioration of the structure and potential safety concerns of the original 1898 design, is to be rebuilt as a multi-use/pedestrian bridge to reconnect Brighton Heights to Riverview Park. The prior structure which featured state of the art concepts and materials for its time and had been rehabbed in 1986 had finally exceeded its design life. The proposed bridge will seek to emulate its predecessor while embracing new technology to minimize construction costs and impacts the adjacent communities. Design is scheduled to begin immediately and will take approximately one year. Construction is expected to be completed in one season. Design of the project is funded through the city’s capital budget with support from an Allegheny County GEDF Grant.
