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## West End – 20<sup>th</sup> Ward

Saw Mill Run is a major waterway that drains water from the southern portion of the City to the Ohio River near the West End Bridge. The stream flows along SR 0051.

The City has the maintenance responsibilities to keep the stream and channel in good repair. This helps minimize flooding during a rain event. After this project is complete in the spring of 2022, the USACE will perform additional repairs to the stream channel to fix recent storm damage.



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
