

Electrical and HVAC Contractor license requirements

The International Code Council will no longer offer the Pittsburgh specific electrical and mechanical certification exams. Beginning immediately, PLI will accept the National Standard Master Electrical and Mechanical Certification for contractor licenses. For renewal applications, we will continue to accept the Pennsylvania Standard Master Electrician/Mechanical Exam (Pittsburgh) or National Standard Master Electrician/Mechanical Exams. Our website has been updated to reflect these changes.

As previously announced, PLI will be reviewing all plans in house beginning February 1, 2018. We will no longer accept Third Party Approved drawings. We will still require Third Party Agency inspections for electrical permits until further notice.
