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28<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge – Originally constructed in 1931

**Polish Hill/Strip District** – The 28<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, constructed in its current form in 1931 on piers from the original structure c1890, has in recent years seen restrictions to its vehicle loading and an increased frequency of maintenance and inspection. DOMI, with support from PennDOT and a team of engineers and designers, are evaluating the feasibility of rehabilitating the bridge. The truss is considered to be in fair condition, so with targeted repairs and retrofits as well as improving multi-modal access and the approaches of the structure, the department seeks to modernize the 28<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge for a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Pittsburgh.

Design is anticipated to take through 2025 with construction tentatively planned for 2025. With the design just getting underway, the department is planning to seek community feedback on the bridge's form and function in Spring 2023.
