SUMMARY:

Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority is seeking a candidate with a strong knowledge and experience with Supervisory, Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA). The right candidate will be responsible for maintaining the SCADA system infrastructure while ensuring water regulatory standards are met. The ideal candidate will have the ability to provide hands-on implementation, support, maintenance, upgrades and troubleshooting, including network infrastructure, to achieve the highest quality of water and system reliability.

DUTIES/PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Serves as a point of contact to the Senior SCADA Manager and water production team at the Water Treatment Plant regarding all instrumentation and SCADA operation.
- Installs and maintains communication equipment.
- Troubleshoots all connectivity issues involving the SCADA and networks at the treatment plant and satellite locations, including but not limited to the pumping stations.
- Maintain, install, configure and backup/restore SCADA system software.
- Assist with managing the security assets connected to the SCADA system.
- Maintain SCADA and instrumentation at field sites as needed.
- Develop reports using SQL and PI Historian within the SCADA system.
- Programming of PLC's and OIT's
- Review drawings with the Senior SCADA Manager for all SCADA-related projects, including new construction.
- Communicates verbally and in writing to share and transfer institutional knowledge with the Senior SCADA Manager, water production management, and staff regarding SCADA.
- Responsible for the creation and continuous update of a daily SCADA log book.
- Responds to requests from the Senior SCADA Manager and Senior Production Manager in coordinating the day to day operations of the SCADA system.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Water Production Management team, as needed.
- Responds to emergency call outs regarding SCADA system malfunctions.

KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES:

Knowledge of process instrumentation, including flow and analytical instruments. Experience with calibration and test equipment, troubleshooting, repair and maintenance of process control equipment. Knowledge of wiring schematics and field instrument wiring. Understanding and working knowledge of PLC and HMI equipment. Knowledge of the following software platforms: Rockwell, Schneider Electric, and Maple Systems.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must become domiciled within one of the following Pennsylvania counties: Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Lawrence, Indiana, Washington or Westmoreland at time of appointment and remain domiciled within one of the noted counties throughout employment with the PWSA. Verification of domicile is required at time of appointment. Applicants must present a current, valid Class C (Class 1) Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Operator's License prior to appointment. A valid driver's license must be maintained throughout employment.
