



**mentor2.0** pairs college-educated volunteers in one-to-one mentoring relationships with ninth-grade STEAM students at Pittsburgh Brashear High School. A unique combination of technology and curriculum empowers volunteers to become an effective support to students through high school and beyond.

## HOW IT WORKS

**Flexibility** Everyone can accommodate the time commitment, including the busiest corporate executives and traveling professionals. Block off just two hours one evening per month for the in-person event; fulfill the remaining responsibilities remotely.

**Structure** Much of the mentoring interactions will be guided by a customized curriculum. Email prompts will help volunteers say the right things at the right times; pre-planned activities will facilitate in-person connections.

**Impact** Every mentor2.0 volunteer can provide a high school student with the support and guidance they need to graduate from high school and succeed in college and the workforce.

## VOLUNTEER INFO

### Volunteer Responsibilities

- Complete application, brief enrollment interview and training
- Exchange weekly online communications with mentee
- Participate in a two-hour group event one evening per month at Brashear High School (dates/times provided before school year begins)
- Commit two school years to the program—ideally, relationships will last through high school

### Volunteer Requirements:

- At least 21 years old
- College-educated (Associate's degree or higher)
- Live or work in the Pittsburgh area
