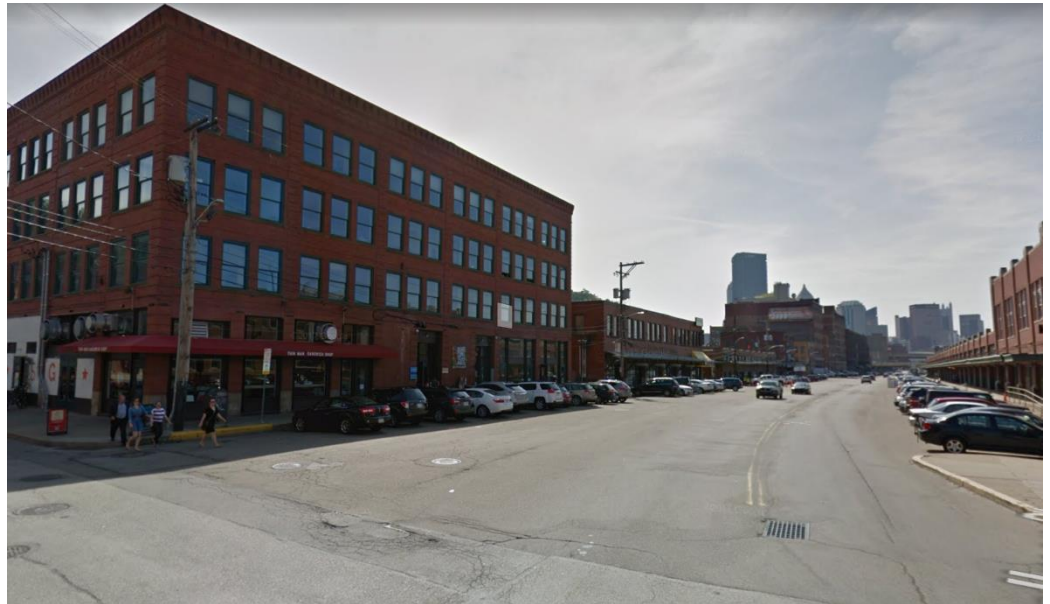

The Smallman Street project intends to improve pedestrian and bicycle travel along Smallman Street. The project includes sidewalk improvements in front of established and new businesses alike, new lighting, and safety features to create a more inviting and safe atmosphere for patrons. New crosswalks will link the current business district with the ongoing project at the produce terminal, which will provide opportunity for new businesses to enter into the historic shopping district. A proposed plaza will provide café seating and outdoor event space.

The project is in the final stages of design and is expected to be at 100% design by the end of 2019. Construction is expected to start early Spring of 2020 and will finish by the end of Summer.
