

The primary purposes in this project will be the widening of Wenzell Avenue, reconstruction of sidewalk, Concrete steps, along with utility and drainage upgrades will improve traffic flow and pedestrian safety. This project will include a full replacement of the existing Carnahan Road Bridge that goes over Banksville Creek to 3 lanes in lieu of the current 2 lanes to accommodate a left turn lane from Carnahan Road to northbound Banksville Road.

The project will begin around October 2019 and have a completion date of November 2020 weather permitting. Allison Park Contractors, Inc. will be the contractor performing the construction.



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
