



# Forward – Monitor Trail

## Greenfield

The Forward Monitor Trail is the first section of a proposed pedestrian/bicycle route which when completed, will connect pedestrians and bicyclists of the upper Greenfield/lower Squirrel Hill neighborhoods to the Eliza Furnace Trail, as well as Downtown Pittsburgh, Oakland, Southside Works, Pittsburgh Technology Center and the new Almono development in Hazelwood.

Because of the topography of the area, many different scenarios are being investigated. Other portions of the trail, still in the design phase, may utilize routes along the north side of the Parkway East (I-376) and Pocusset Street, eventually connecting to Saline Street in The Run section of Greenfield.
