This is a galvanized steel bin wall approximately 240' long, 13' high, constructed in 1983. At one bin, the stringers have failed due to corrosion. The granular backfill is falling out creating a void behind it. This portion of the street is the only access to a home located at 616 Angle Street. I was first made aware of this issue in July, 2019.

I contacted a company called Contech Construction Projects, Inc. and spoke with one of their engineers regarding this, and the availability of repair parts.

The material has been purchased to do the repairs to the wall. A proposal has been requested and accepted from a contractor in the amount of \$24,500.00. The project start date is currently being coordinated.



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
