## Arlington / 16<sup>th</sup> Ward

This project is the design and construction of a retaining wall on Parkwood Road, located in the Arlington neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh.

Settlement of the road was noticed in the summer of 2017, and in 2018 the road collapsed, causing its closure at the east portion of the Road.

Residents from the Arlington neighborhood can access Becks Run Road by using Parkwood Road.

The project final design started in October 2019 and is estimated to be completed by March 2020. After the final design is completed, DOMI will be ready to advertise the project for construction. This project is not currently funded for 2020.
