East Allegheny Neighborhoods

This project is the reconstruction of the city steps that connect Chestnut St with Vista St on the East Allegheny neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh. These steps represent an important pedestrian connection in the area, as identified in a study made by DOMI. The existing steps were built in 1944, and are currently closed due to the poor condition of the structure, causing pedestrians a major detour.

The project is right now in construction. The project started in November 2019 and be completed in May 2020.

When the project is complete, the pedestrian mobility of the community will be reestablished and improved. DOMI has been in contact with the community through the Office of Community Affairs to provide them project updates.
