Penn Ave, Phase II is a project constructing streetscape improvements along Penn Avenue between and including the intersections of Evaline and Graham Streets. The project will include the construction of new sidewalks, curbs, and cartway, and will include various forms of storm water mitigation with a focus on green infrastructure. Public utilities have been invited to replace old and deteriorating assets while the road is being reconstructed.

The purpose of this rehabilitation is to enhance the corridor for pedestrian and vehicular travel alike. The improved sidewalks and crosswalks will provide an added component of safety to for residents and customers walking next to the street, and bumpouts constructed at each intersection will assist in the calming of traffic while at the same time delineating the on-street parking areas.

The design of this street is intended to improve the sense of community among the residents in Bloomfield and Garfield, while benefitting business by creating an inviting streetscape for pedestrians and customers.
