On January 1, 2018, the annual federal limit for retirement plan contributions increased to \$18,500. That means you can contribute more to the ALOM / City of Pittsburgh Deferred Compensation Plan in 2018. If you're age 50 or older, you can make an additional \$6,000 in catch up contributions.

To make a change to your contribution rate and save the most you can, complete the attached salary reduction form and return it to your payroll department.
