



OneStopPGH COVID-19 Updates

PLI's temporary operations have been updated as follows in light of Governor Wolf's Executive Order that all non-life sustaining businesses cease operations, including construction

- All construction work must be halted until the Order is lifted.
- If you believe that the suspension of construction activities would create a dangerous and/or unsafe condition, please contact your inspector or PLIConstructionSupervisors@pittsburghpa.gov.
- If you require an emergency permit due to emergency work, please apply online at [OneStopPGH](#), describe the work as emergency in the Description, and email PLIAppTech@pittsburghpa.gov to identify the work as emergency.

COVID-19 Trade License Update

- PLI is aware of reported difficulties in obtaining [Continuing Education Units \(CEUs\)](#) due to the ongoing [COVID-19 state of emergency](#).
- To accommodate those experiencing these difficulties, PLI will extend the grace period for all [Trade License Holders](#) from a 60 day period to a 120 day period. This change will be effective until June 15th, 2020.
- On June 15th, 2020, license terms will return to conforming with the grace period defined

in the [Licensing Rules and Regulations](#).
